BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Mrs. Ko

She thanked Cathy Milligan for her service and stated that it was great to serve with her. She wished her luck in her retirement.

She stated that she loves receiving emails and other communication from the public. However, she reminded everyone that a level of mutual respect should be maintained between all parties. The Board and district employees are not to be treated as doormats. The public can expect timely responses, but emails that are demanding in nature come across as disrespectful. She invited the public to continue to communicate with her.

Mr. Kearns

He stated that the resolutions passed tonight will be sent to the county auditor's office to certify the millage rates. The Board will use the information when deciding if action will be taken.

He stated that the decision making process (regarding a levy request) has been an ongoing review of information provided by Mrs. Lane including monthly financial statements and five year projections. Recently the Board began "more active" discussions regarding a levy request.

The Board has taken steps to reduce expenditures. However, the Board cannot continue to make cuts and maintain the quality school district that the community demands.

The Board will review the county auditor's response and could take action at the next meeting to move forward with one of the levy options.
