

STATEMENT FOR USE OF CRIMINAL (OR BCII) RECORD CHECK

The Board may employ persons responsible for the care, custody or control of students on the condition that the candidate submit to and pass a BCII criminal record check in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code. This will include information from the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The Board may use this criminal record check as part of the initial hiring process and at various times during an employment career. As an applicant for employment by Fairfield City Schools, your written authorization to obtain the criminal record check will be obtained prior to conducting the criminal record check.

Note: State law requires individuals responsible for the care and custody of children to submit to criminal record checks for initial and renewal of licenses, certificates or permits; and every five years if holding an eight-year provisional teaching certificate or permanent teaching certificate.
