

ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEES

The Superintendent may establish such permanent or temporary committees which are necessary for proper administration of the Board policies and for the improvement of the total educational program.

All committees created by the Superintendent will be for the purposes of obtaining the advice and counsel of administrative and supervisory personnel of the District and aiding in District communication. Functioning in an advisory capacity, such groups may make recommendations for submission to the Board through the Superintendent. Authority for establishing policy remains with the Board; authority and responsibility for implementing policy remain with the Superintendent.

The membership composition and responsibilities of administrative committees will be defined by the Superintendent and may be changed at his/her discretion.
