

FIRST AID

The Superintendent in conjunction with the School Nurse Unit Leader will develop and issue regulations containing procedures for the emergency care of any student, staff member, or parent/community member who is injured or becomes suddenly ill at school or while engaged in or attending other school-sponsored activities. These regulations will be followed by all school personnel. In the case of an emergency involving a student, the emergency medical authorization form is followed and efforts made to contact the parent/guardian.

The Board authorizes the use of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and the Heimlich maneuver by trained school personnel according to regulations promulgated by the Superintendent. The Board further authorizes the use of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) by members of a core emergency response team of trained school personnel according to regulations promulgated by the Superintendent.

The Board authorizes training in these first aid procedures for those individuals designated by the Superintendent.
