

SUMMER SCHOOLS

A self-supporting summer school is authorized by the Board for the benefit of both District and non-District students. A summer school program will provide programs to the extent of available school personnel facilities and in accordance with standards prescribed by the Ohio Department of Education.

The purpose of the summer school is to provide, on a tuition basis, courses and/or training to meet the identified needs and interests of the students. Courses may be offered for enrichment, make-up, repeat and/or remedial work, advance credit and for other areas of need. Courses will be offered subject to sufficient enrollment.

Summer school will be under the direction of a summer school head teacher or principal as appointed by the Board. Teachers for summer school classes will be recruited from the District staff insofar as feasible. The Board will set summer school salaries and make appointments upon the recommendation of the Superintendent.
