

STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

School Clubs

The Board recognizes the importance of school clubs in providing opportunities for students to develop their individual interests and capabilities.

All organized clubs shall have an approved sponsor.

Requests for forming a new club are to be through the building principal, subject to the approval of the Superintendent.

The organized clubs should be diversified so as to meet the needs of a maximum number of students in a variety of areas including but not restricted to:

1. academic and scholastic interests;
2. musical;
3. dramatic;
4. scientific;
5. social;
6. leadership and
7. writing or productive thinking.

Student Councils

Representatives are elected to student councils for the following reasons:

1. to encourage the acceptance and discharge of student responsibilities to themselves and to the school;
2. to stimulate a spirit of cooperation between students and faculty;
3. to give students a voice in their own government and
4. to aid in the development of loyal, constructive school spirit.
