

INTERSCHOLASTIC EXTRACURRICULAR ELIGIBILITY

Students may be excluded from participating in an activity if they have less than a 1.0 grade point average on a 4.0 grading scale.

Students Enrolled in Grades 9 – 12

1. In the immediately preceding grading period, a student must receive a passing grade in a minimum of four (4) one-credit courses or the equivalent, which counts toward graduation; and
2. A student enrolled in the first grading period after advancement from the eighth grade must have passed 75% of those subjects taken during the preceding grading period in which the student was enrolled; and
3. Those grades must, when combined, be a total grade point average of at least 1.0 on a four-point (4.0) scale.

Students Enrolled in Grades 7 – 8

1. A student enrolled in the first grading period after advancement from the eighth grade must have passed a minimum of five of all subjects carried the preceding grading period in which the student was enrolled; and
2. A student enrolling in the 7th grade for the first time will be eligible for the first grading period regardless of previous academic achievement. Thereafter, in order to be eligible, a student in grade 7 or 8 must be currently enrolled in school the immediately preceding grading period and received passing grades during that grading period in a minimum of five of those subjects in which the student received grades; and
3. Those grades referenced above must, when combined, be a total grade point average of at least 1.0 on a four-point (4.0) scale.

Pass/Fail Policy

Any student who received a failing grade for any class or course of study for the previous grading period will be eligible to participate in interscholastic extra-curricular activities provided he/she meets all of the grade point average requirements.

A student with an IEP is exempt from the grading provisions set forth in this policy.
