

STUDENT DEMONSTRATIONS AND STRIKES

Demonstrations in the nature of so-called boycotts, walkouts, sit-ins, strikes, etc., by individuals or groups cause disruptions to the school program. Students who plan, or help to organize, or participate in such demonstrations are disrupting the school program and are subject to penalties, suspension, or expulsion.

In the event of any unlawful demonstration or protest by students, the primary concern of the staff shall be for the safety and rights of the nonparticipant and the protection of school property.
