

## **FOREIGN LANGUAGE**

9            1 credit            1 Term

**(Prerequisite for all foreign language courses: Teacher recommendation based on successful completion of previous level. Students must achieve a grade of “C” or better to take the next year of a language. All students enrolled in foreign language courses should also be enrolled in College Prep or Advanced Placement/Honors level English courses.)**

### **Fees for Foreign Language:**

- **French - \$24.00**
- **French II - \$24.00**
- **German - \$21.00**
- **Spanish - \$22.00**
- **Spanish II - \$5**

\*Students should keep purchased workbook from the previous year. If lost, student will need to purchase another workbook at full cost.

Students have the opportunity to complete at least four years of foreign language instruction in German and Latin and five years in French and Spanish. Most students will begin their foreign language program at the start of their ninth grade year, although some students will have begun their instruction in the eighth grade. Your current foreign language teacher, your language arts teachers, and your counselor are the best persons to make recommendations about what level to choose.

While two years of the same language technically qualifies as the foreign language entrance requirement for most colleges, it is strongly recommended by both colleges and by the high school that you complete three years of instruction in the same language.

Students must achieve a grade of “C” or better to take the next year of a language. All students enrolled in foreign language courses should also be enrolled in College Prep or Advanced Placement/ Honors level English courses.
