

STAFF CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Employees of the Board will not engage in, nor have a financial interest in, any activity which conflicts with their duties and responsibilities in the school system.

Employees will not engage in work of any type in which information concerning customer, client or employer originates from any information available to them through school sources.

Employees will not sell textbooks, instructional supplies, equipment and reference books to the schools in the District. They will not furnish the names of students or parents to anyone selling these materials. Employees must not recommend any commercial product or service, or aid in distributing literature or publicity endorsing or recommending such product or service. District employees shall not use the name of the District, or a school, or their own official titles, in the commercial promotion of any product, process or service normally associated with school operations.

In order that there will be no conflict of interest in the supervision and evaluation of employees, at no time may any administrator or other employee responsible for the supervision and/or evaluation of an employee be related to that employee. Whenever possible, relatives or spouses shall not be assigned to the same school plant.
