

FEDERAL FUNDS

It is the objective of the Board to provide equal educational opportunities for all students within the District. Therefore, it is the intent of the Board to study Federal legislation to provide better educational opportunities, better educational environment, and better physical and mental growth for each student.

The Superintendent or designee shall review new Federal education legislation and prepare proposals for programs he/she deems would be of aid to the students of this District. The Superintendent shall approve each such proposal prior to its submission, and the Board shall approve all grants resulting from such proposals.

The Board regards available Federal funds of aid to Local School Districts and communities as a public trust. It forbids the use of Federal monies for partisan political activities and for any use that would not be in accord with Federal guidelines on discrimination. The Superintendent shall ensure that each draw of Federal monies is as close as administratively feasible to the related program expenditures.
