

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS SECURITY

Buildings and grounds of the District constitute one of the greatest investments of the Board. It is in the best interest of the District to protect the investment adequately.

Security means not only maintenance of a secure building but also includes protection from fire hazards, faulty equipment and unsafe practices in the use of electrical, plumbing and heating equipment. The Board requires close cooperation with local police and fire departments and with insurance company inspectors.

Access to school buildings and grounds outside of regular school hours will be limited to personnel whose work requires such access. An adequate key control system will be established, which will limit access to buildings to authorized personnel and will guard against entrance to buildings by persons unauthorized to have keys.

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
