

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION IN PRIVATE VEHICLES

It is the Board's intent to transport students to regular daily classes and all special functions on Board-owned vehicles or on chartered vehicles approved by the Board through the Assistant Superintendent's office. Except in extenuating situations, students are not to be transported in private vehicles.

The Assistant Superintendent shall be authorized to arrange and recommend such contractual provisions for the transportation of students by private buses, cars or other facilities where regular school bus transportation is not feasible or sufficient.

If it is necessary to use private vehicles, evidence must be presented to the Assistant Superintendent that the vehicle and driver are covered for liability, medical payments, physical damage and uninsured motorist liability. The Board will maintain excess insurance through a non ownership liability endorsement to its bus fleet insurance policy covering all private vehicles used for transportation to and from student activities.
