

STUDENT DISMISSAL PRECAUTIONS

Permission for a student to leave school when school is in session will require approval by the principal or a person specifically designated by him/her to exercise that authority. In evaluating requests for this permission, the authority will give primary consideration to the best interest of the student and/or public welfare. Requests will not be approved without a parent's or guardian's permission. When a request originates from a person other than the parent or guardian, the school official in authority will contact the parent or guardian to obtain permission; an exception may be made in the case of the student who is 18 years of age or older, who may make requests on his/her own behalf.
