

## EXCLUSIONS AND EXEMPTIONS FROM SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

A child of compulsory school age residing in the District may be legally excused from public school attendance by:

1. holding a full-time age and schooling certificate and being regularly employed;
2. receiving approved home instruction;
3. attending a private, parochial school or home schooling,; or
4. having graduated from an approved high school.

The District may temporarily deny admittance to any student who is otherwise entitled to be admitted to a public school in the District if the student has been expelled or suspended from the schools of another district in the State of Ohio or an out-of-state district and if the period of expulsion or suspension has not expired. The student and parent(s) have an opportunity for a hearing before the Superintendent/designee to determine the admittance or non-admittance of the student.
