

STUDENT DRESS CODE

All students shall attend school in a manner which is clean, not hazardous to their health and safety or the safety of others, and which does not detract from the required educational environment. The Board directs the Superintendent to issue regulations to carry out the purpose and intent of this policy, upon review by the Board. The Board delegates to the administrators and faculty of each school the responsibility for seeing that students adhere to a reasonable and proper standard of dress.

Requirements include:

1. Dress and grooming standards require cleanliness in the interest of health, sanitary conditions and safety requirements.
2. When a student is participating in school activities, his/her dress and grooming will not disrupt his/her performance or that of other students or constitute a health threat to himself/herself or other students.
3. Dress and grooming will not be such as to disrupt the teaching-learning process.
