

DETENTION OF STUDENTS

If a student violates any rule or regulation, he/she may be punished by being kept before, during, or after school in a detention period set up by the principal through established building procedures. Parents or guardians are to be notified of the detention by procedures set at each building and of the reason it was given. There is no appeal of the detention decision beyond the level of building principal.

The detention periods are to be supervised by school personnel. A student is not to be excused from detention to participate in athletic events or extracurricular activities.

Saturday School

Saturday School will be used as an alternative plan to improve behavior without having students lose instructional time.
