

**INOCULATIONS OF STUDENTS**  
**Required Student Immunizations**  
Effective with the 2010- 2011 school year

**Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus (DTaP/DTP/DT/Tdap/Td)**

**Kindergarten-** 5 (five) doses of DTaP, DTP, or DT, or any combination, if the 4th dose was administered before the 4th birthday.

**Grades 1-12-** 3-4 (three to four) doses of DTaP, DTP, or Td or any combination

**Grade 7-** 1 (one) dose of Tdap or Td vaccine must be administered prior to entry

**Poliomyelitis (OPV, IPV)**

**Kindergarten-** 4 (four) doses of any combination of OPV or IPV, the final dose must be administered on or after the 4th birthday regardless of the number of doses.

**Grades 1-12\*\*** - 4 (four) doses if a combination of OPV or IPV was administered.

4 (four) doses of all OPV or all IPV is required if the third dose of either vaccine was administered prior to the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.

**Rubeola, Rubella, Mumps (MMR)**

**K-12** – 2 (two) doses required with 1st dose being administered on or after the first birthday. The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after the 1st.

**Hepatitis B**

**K through 11**

3 (three) doses required. The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after the first dose. The third dose must be given at least 16 weeks after the first dose and at least 8 weeks after the second dose. The last dose in the series must not be administered before age 24 weeks.

**Varicella (Chicken Pox)**

**Kindergarten** – 2 (two) doses of varicella vaccine must be administered prior to entry.

**Grades 1-4** – 1 (one) dose of varicella vaccine must be administered on or after the first birthday

**Mantoux T.B test**

Required for new students in grades K through 12 enrolling from other countries or an area of the United States considered to be at risk for T.B.

\*\*Students enrolled in school on or after the 1999-2000 school year should have received a total of four doses of polio vaccine. Students enrolled prior to the 1999-2000 school year are required to have a minimum of three doses.

The four day grace period applies to all age and interval minimums. If MMR and Varicella have not been given on the same day they must be separated by at least 28 days with no grace period.

The Hepatitis B, Tdap and Varicella requirements will be progressive.

Only full doses of vaccines using proper intervals shall be counted as valid doses.

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
