

STUDENT AUTOMOBILE USE

It is often times necessary for students to drive automobiles to school. In the interest of safety, student driving practices will be subject to strict control.

The principal shall establish rules and regulations outlining the use and parking of vehicles by students who operate automobiles and other motor vehicles on school property. A student's right to drive to school may be suspended for violation of these rules and regulations.

In compliance with State law, student drivers under the age of 17 years old are not permitted to transport more than one person who is not a family member unless the driver is accompanied by his/her parent, guardian or custodian.

Students are discouraged from transporting other students to and from student activities, events, and programs.
