September 2 is right around the corner...

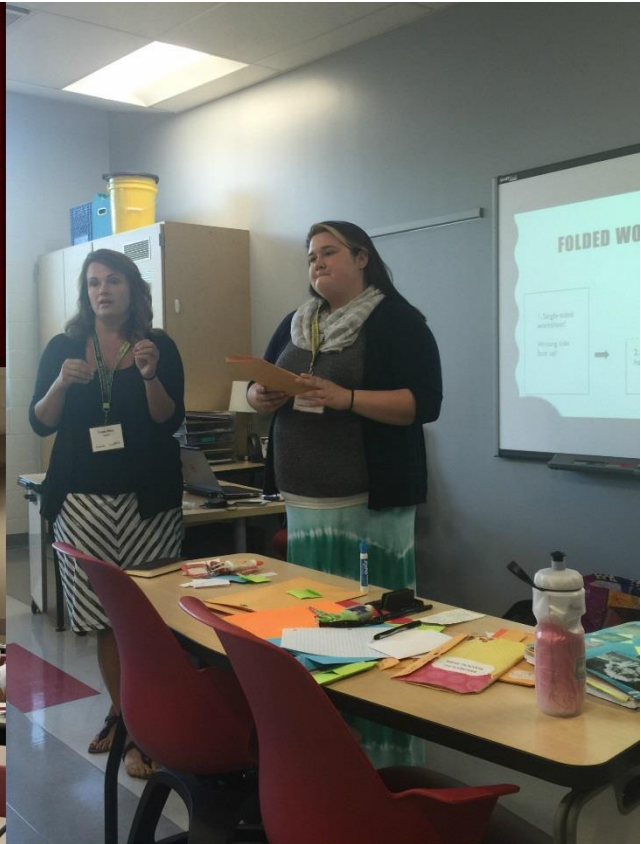
