 - Guest must be an FHS student – includes FHS students who attend classes off campus (Academy, Butler Tech, CCP, Virtual Learner) and must be 10th or 11th grade only. You may not change your guest once tickets have been purchased.

There will be a box by the Bookkeeper's office as well as a box in the Main office where paperwork can be turned in.

- ◆ Students will need to show ticket at door for entry. You may print a copy of the ticket, take a picture or download the Hometown Ticketing app to your mobile device.
 - ◆ Tickets can only be scanned 1 time before they become invalid.
 - ◆ Students will be required to enter their FHS student ID for electronic verification at the door.
 - ◆ Students will be subject to temperature check before entry.
 - ◆ Masks must be worn at all times.

CODE OF CONDUCT for PROM 2021

Dear Students and Parents,

As with any school function, students are required to follow the school's code of conduct. In addition to those rules, the following guidelines are requirements for us to safely have Prom while following current COVID-19 guidelines. If at any time these directives are ignored, the student will be asked to leave and/or parent called.

- Students and staff must perform a self-assessment the day of the event and monitor themselves for fever or sickness. They should not attend if they have symptoms.
- Do not gather in homes or other indoor spaces before or after prom.
- Only students from our school are allowed.
- Masks must be worn at all times by staff and participants.
- Dancing is allowed, but masks must be worn at all times. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- The only time you will be allowed to have your mask down is while you are sitting down at a table and actively drinking or eating. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- All attendees must be seated when eating or drinking.
- Do not move tables or chairs they have been social distanced per guidelines.
- Hand sanitizer should be conveniently located on every table.
- If you feel sick during Prom, tell a chaperone and leave the venue.
- If you feel sick or test positive for COVID-19 after the prom, inform the school.

To be permitted to partake in this prom, you are required to sign this document to show that you completely understand the rules and regulations. And that at any time you do not follow our guidelines, you will be asked to leave and/or parent called

Fairfield City School Districts Prom and Code of Conduct Waiver

All participants in the Fairfield High School's prom have an important role to play in keeping other students within the school, their peers, and their community member's safe by doing their part to stop the spread of COVID-19. As a student in FCSD, I know that I must take steps to stay well in order to protect others and promote a safe return to school and full participation for all students in my school. Because of this challenge, I pledge to take responsibility for my own health and help stop the spread of the COVID-19.

Fairfield City School District's highest priority is the safety of all the students, faculty, staff, and guests. I know that by engaging in school activities, including attending classes, pursuing my education, eating in the school cafeteria, attending activities, participating in sports and recreation and prom, I may be exposed to COVID-19 and other infections. I also understand that despite all reasonable efforts by my school, I can still contract COVID-19 and other infections. In order to reduce my risk, I agree to be an active participant in maintaining my own health, wellbeing and safety, as well as the safety of others, by following all the guidelines and expectations outlined by my school.

As more information is gathered and known, I understand that my school, via its Board of Education or governing board, may modify these guidelines and expectations. It is my responsibility to make every effort to keep myself apprised of these changes to protect myself and my school community.

It is my school pledge to protect myself, my peers, and my entire community by doing the following:

- I agree to testing for COVID-19 and potential subsequent self-quarantining if I am identified as a contact of anyone who has been determined to be positive for COVID-19.
- If I test positive for COVID-19, I agree to self-quarantine in a location to be determined in consultation with my family, a medical practitioner and/or local health department until:
 - My symptoms have resolved, and
 - It has been at least ten days since the start of my symptoms
- I agree to timely report any known or potential exposures to COVID-19 to the schools administration
 - Monitor for the following symptoms:
 - A fever of 100.4 or higher
 - Respiratory symptoms, such as dry cough or shortness of breath
 - Sore throat
 - Headache
 - Body aches
 - Chills
 - Loss of taste or smell
- If I develop the above symptoms, I agree to contact my school administrator and/or medical practitioner, and to follow the medical staff's instructions which may include being tested for COVID-19 and self-quarantining while the test results are pending.
- Stay at home if I am feeling sick
- Participate fully and honestly with the administrative staff for contact tracing to determine whom I might have potentially exposed to COVID-19.
- Wear a mask or the appropriate PPE in all public spaces.

- Practice physical distancing as much as possible per the ODH orders.
- Frequently wash or sanitize my hands.
- Keep my personal space, shared common space, and my belongings clean.

I understand COVID-19 is a highly contagious virus, and it is possible to develop and contract the COVID-19 disease, even if I follow all the safety precautions above and those recommended by the CDC, local health department, and others. I understand that although my school is following the coronavirus guidelines issued by the CDC and other experts to reduce the spread of infection, I can never be completely shielded from all risk of illness caused by COVID-19 or other infections. I assume the risks of my participation in school events, including extracurricular and co-curricular events.

I have read, understand, and agree to comply with this pledge above. I also acknowledge that these expectations are a condition of my participation in prom and that any failure to comply with this pledge above may lead to immediate removal from the event.

I take this pledge seriously and will do my part to protect my school and community.
