RESOLUTION APPROVING A SCHOOL COMPENSATION AGREEMENT WITH THE FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND APPROVING AND WAIVING RIGHTS TO CERTAIN NOTICE OF TAX INCREMENT FINANCING EXEMPTIONS BY THE FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES ON SPECIFIC REAL PROPERTY.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Fairfield City School District as follows:

- a. The School Compensation Agreement between the Fairfield City School District Board of Education and Fairfield Township Board of Trustees for the Duke Site Property on Seward Road on file in the office of the Treasurer is hereby approved and the President and Treasurer are hereby authorized to execute the same on behalf of this Board.
- b. Provided that the Fairfield Township Board of Trustees approves and executes the School Compensation Agreement before approving any TIF tax exemptions on the specific real property identified in the School Compensation Agreement, the Fairfield City School District Board of Education hereby approves and waives its right to notice of such exemptions under Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.73 and 5709.83 as to the real property identified in the School Compensation Agreement only.

This approval and waiver of notice shall have no application to any other real property located in Fairfield Township, Butler County, Ohio.
