ITEMS FOR BOARD DISCUSSION

A. Proposed changes to board policy EBCD Emergency Closings - Billy Smith

Mr. Smith stated that a law enforcement emergency must be included in the reasons for a school closing per the Ohio School Boards Association.

In addition, contingency plans for a calamity day cannot conflict with the bargaining agreement.

The policy will be brought back at a later board meeting for approval.

- B. Proposed board policy IGBEA Reading Skills Assessments and Interventions Lani Wildow
- C. Race to the Top update Roger Martin

Mr. Martin presented the following information:

- 1. Race to the Top groups met over the summer to identify/develop 500 individual student growth measures during the course of this year, which will be used in the new teacher evaluation process that begins next year. Groups will continue to meet throughout the year.
- 2. All nine of our schools will be piloting the new teacher evaluation model this school year.

Building principals and nine teachers who took the training are in the process of being credentialed as evaluators for the new process.

Over 20 teachers have volunteered to be evaluated this year as part of the process.

3. Year two of the standards roll-out has begun.

Approximately one third of the teachers in the district including English Language Arts 3-8, 10 and 12th grades; Math K-8 and 10th grades and Science PreK-12th grades will be receiving ongoing professional development throughout the year on the new standards.

Another one third of our teachers will receive follow-up from last year's work with a close look at standards.

Teachers will be working to develop formative and summative assessments.

They will be exploring the new state assessments which will be in place the next few years.

They will be looking at how instruction is delivered and how student growth will be measured.

- 4. The state has rolled out a new stock/take assessment which we are working on to measure the progress of our Race to the Top work. This will be followed later in the year with a face to face meeting to provide an update to the state regarding our work.
- 5. In regards to Professional Development Plan we scored 49 out of 50 points on the scoring rubric.
- D. Financial Review Committee update on action steps Billy Smith

The school district has entered into a rate lock with Duke Energy that will save the district \$46,000 in 2014.

E. Bach Lane property – update regarding required repairs – Billy Smith

Mr. Smith advised that the request to advertise bids for up to nine HVAC units is the result of theft of units from the site.

He stated that the request for structural repairs is to repair termite and water damage on the wood framework that will allow the project to move forward. The company with the lowest estimate is listed for approval.

Mr. Murray asked if there is insurance coverage for the costs of replacement. Mr. Smith stated that there is coverage.
